What are the eligibility requirements for SKL Class XLVII?

An applicant should

- Be between the ages of 25 and 45 on the date applications are due.
- Have both a demonstrated interest in community issues and a record of leadership in significant voluntary community activities.
- Occupy a position of leadership reflecting significant achievement relative to age and providing the opportunity to have significant influence on issues facing our community.
- Have lived in the Greater Indianapolis/Central Indiana area for at least three years and have a likelihood of staying in the area for the foreseeable future.
- Be able to commit to the attendance and time requirements.

When is the SKL Class XLVII application due?

Completed applications may be hand-delivered or mailed. Hand-delivered applications must be delivered on or before 4PM on Wednesday, April 26. Mailed applications must be postmarked on or before Wednesday, April 26. Late applications will not be accepted.

Will I receive confirmation that my application has been received?

Applicants will receive email notification by the end of May confirming their application has been received.

When will I be notified of the selection committee's decision?

Applicants will be notified in late July as to whether they have been selected to participate in SKL Class XLVII.

What are the key dates for SKL Class XLVII?

March 21, 2023 – Application is available for download at www.leadershipindianapolis.com

April 26, 2023 – Applications are due

Late July – Applicants are notified about their acceptance status

Early August – Class and Moderator are announced

September – Class year begins with orientation and a two-day, out-of-town opening retreat

October – May – Class meets once a month for a full-day session

June – Class year ends with a two-day, out-of-town closing retreat

Who serves on the selection committee?

The selection committee is made up of community members familiar with the SKL Series and remains anonymous. The committee is made up of different people each year.

Who is the Moderator for SKL Class XLVII?

The Moderator for SKL Class XLVII will be announced in early August, along with the class members.
